1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.301 dated 12.11.2024 registered under Sections 118(2), 115(2), 74, 191(3) & 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

2. While issuing notice of motion and granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner on 27.01.2025, he was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dharminder Singh, submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation as he has been arrested in case FIR No.36 dated 14.02.2025 registered under Section 22/61/85 of N.D.P.S. Act, 1985 at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has not joined the investigation in the present FIR as during the period of ad interim anticipatory bail, he has committed another offence under the NDPS Act and arrested in case FIR No.36 dated 14.02.2025 registered under Sections 22/61/85 of N.D.P.S. Act, 1985 at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, therefore, he does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail in the present case.

5. Consequently, the instant petition is dismissed.
