The counsel for the petitioner submits that the possession of the vacant shop is already handed over to the respondent by the petitioner in May, 2023 and the petitioner is also willing to make the payment of all the due with regard to mense profit, but at present is having financial problem and as such will be able to make the payment only in installments and the petitioner offered to pay the due amount in monthly installments of Rs.4,000/- each and he is ready to enhance the said amount to Rs10,000/- per month.
