1. Present petition has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.33, dated 04.04.2024, under Sections 457, 380 & 411 IPC registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom as it amounts to abuse of the process of law, along with certain other prayers.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that the compromise has also been arrived at between the parties qua the petitioner. However, he submits that the challan is presented.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this court to withdraw the present petition,



with liberty to raise all his pleas before the learned trial court as the charged are yet to be framed. Allowed to do so.

4. The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.

5. Learned trial court would take into consideration the grievances raised by the petitioners before framing the charges. The petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedy in case of any further cause of action arises.
