**AMARJOT BHATTI, J.**

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.432, dated 21.10.2024, under Sections 77 and 78 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, and lateron added Section 67 of Information Technology Act, 2000 registered at Police Station Civil Lines Kaithal, District Kaithal (Annexure P-1).

2. As per facts of the case, complainant filed written complaint for uploading obscene photographs and other things by creating Instagram ID. Unknown person created her Instagram ID and started writing obscene things and sent request to her known persons. The matter was reported to the police and the present FIR was registered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that he was granted interim relief vide order dated 28.11.2024 and thereafter he was granted interim bail vide order dated 18.12.2024. He has already joined the



investigation and he is not required for any other purpose. He is ready to abide by the terms of bail order.

4. State report is filed, confirming that petitioner has joined investigation on 09.12.2024. The mobile phone was also taken into police possession vide separate recovery memo and it is also sent to CFL, Panchkula for forensic analysis. It is confirmed that present petitioner cooperated with the investigating agency.

5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, no purpose would be served by sending the petitioner behind the bars. He has fully cooperated with the investigating agency. Mobile phone was also recovered. Therefore, at this stage, without expressing my mind on the merits of the case, interim bail already granted by the Coordinate Bench on 18.12.2024 is confirmed subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482 (2) BNSS.

6. Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
