The present petition has been filed under Section 483(3) of BNSS for cancellation of anticipatory bail of respondent No.2 granted by this Court vide order dated 18.11.2024 in FIR No.46 dated 5.4.2024 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional (Regulations) Act, 2018 lodged at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the respondent No.2 was served through non-bailable warrants after the order dated 18.11.2024 (Annexure P3) passed by Coordinate Bench granting the anticipatory bail was recalled and his bail was cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the amount has been paid back and nothing is due from respondent No.2-accused and that he has no objection in case the bail to respondent is granted as the whole amount is paid and he has no grudge against him.

In the light of above, respondent No.2 is directed to be released on bail on the same bail/surety bonds as submitted earlier.

The petition is disposed of as not pressed.
