The present application has been filed by applicant-respondent No.3 to review the Judgment dated 03.12.2024 passed by this Court.

2. A perusal of the judgment dated 03.12.2024 shows that there is no mistake apparent on record since the ground taken for review is fresh ground which was never taken before the Ld. Tribunal and no appeal was filed challenging the award dated 09.05.2005 passed by Ld. Tribunal on the ground mentioned in the application. The ground taken in the review is that the amount taken by the Ld. Tribunal is taken without deduction of income tax. Undisputedly, the deceased was self-employed and not a salaried person. Moreso on 03.12.2024, the same argument was raised by learned counsel for respondent No.3 (applicant) and a specific query was put by this Court as to whether the finding of Ld. Tribunal were challenged by the Insurance Company and the reply of the applicant (respondent No.3) was in negative. Since all the issues are dealt with and the



judgment dated 03.12.2024 was passed after hearing all the parties, therefore, there is no mistake apparent on record to review the judgment dated 03.12.2024 passed by this court.

3. In view of the above, the present review application is dismissed.

4. The Insurance Company is hereby directed to disburse the current scheduled fee to Mr. Harsh Aggarwal, Advocate within a period of 20 days from the date of receipt of the copy of this order, in view of the order dated 18.07.2024 passed in FAO No.1682 of 2007 by this Court.
