1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that respondent No.6 Rajiv Luthra Proprietor of M/s Poonam International, Ludhiana was summoned as an accused in criminal complaint titled Ramana International Pvt. Ltd Vs. M/s Poonam International, Shivpuri Street No.1 through Proprietor Rajiv Luthra and another Annexure P-1, under Section 138 NI Act. However, subsequently, respondent No.6 was declared as proclaimed person in the aforesaid criminal complaint. Thereafter, the petitioner has also given complaint/representation Annexure P-3 dated 17.12.2024 with request to the police authorities to arrest respondent No.6. However, no action has been taken by the concerned police officials till date. Being aggrieved, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS seeking necessary directions to the police authorities to ensure the arrest of respondent No.6 who is already declared as proclaimed person in criminal complaint Annexure P-1. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner will be satisfied in case necessary direction is given to



respondents No.2 to 4 to act upon aforesaid representation/complaint Annexure P-3 dated 17.12.2024 and to arrest of respondent No.6 at the earliest without any further delay.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and submits that even till date sincere efforts are being made by the police to apprehend respondent No.6 and that even in future the earnest efforts will be made by the police to ensure the arrest of respondent No.6 who is already declared as proclaimed person in criminal complaint Annexure P-1.

4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to take necessary steps in accordance with law to ensure the arrest of respondent No.6 at the earliest and representation/complaint Annexure P-3 dated 17.12.2024 submitted by the petitioner be decided in accordance with law within a period of next 6 weeks.
