The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 79 dated 27.04.2023 registered under Sections 425, 448, 511, 506, 148, 149, 380, 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 323, 452, 411, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 added later on) at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 09.07.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner

has joined investigation and is no longer required for investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel on instruction from ASI Davinder Singh, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Mr. Arshdeep Singh Brar, Advocate enters appearance on behalf of the complainant and files his Vakalatnama in the Court today which is taken on record.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 09.07.2025 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 482 (2) BNSS.
