Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 18.1.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by a Predecessor Bench of this Court in CWP-1089-2021 titled as "Veena Bhardwaj and others vs. State of Haryana and others" vide which the petition was disposed of directing "*....the Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, Rewari, District Rewari, Haryana, to complete the partition proceedings initiated vide Petition No.4007 of 2015 expeditiously and in any event, not later than 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. The authority shall decide the case on its own merits and in accordance with law and due procedure.....*"



Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that nothing survives in the present contempt petition as the private parties in the Civil Writ Petition No.1089-2021 have settled the matter and exchanged their properties instead of partition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the said fact the present petition may be disposed of.
