Learned counsel appearing for the respondents/contemners would contend that the requisite payment has been released to the petitioner College in due compliance of the directions dated 04.04.2014 passed by this Court in CWP No. 6569 of 2014. Such assertion is not rebutted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the instant contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.

It would, however, be open for the petitioner College to approach the respondents with regard to any discrepancy in the calculations/computations. In the eventuality of any such discrepancies being raised, the respondents would be obligated to consider the same and to take a final view thereupon within a period of six weeks thereafter.
