1. Learned counsel for the respondents has pointed out that in CWP-16904-2021 and other connected cases decided on 22.05.2025 by a Division Bench of this Court, the notification for grant of marks under the Socio-Economic criteria stands quashed. Learned counsel would further contend that in the judgment, qua which the contempt has been alleged, it was directed that marks be given under the Socio-Economic criteria. It is further the contention of the learned counsel that a review application has since been filed in the said petition.

2. In view thereof, no further orders are required to be passed in the present contempt petition at this stage.

3. Dismissed at this stage, with liberty to review in case anything survives. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed off.
