The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.102 dated 17.09.2024, registered under Sections 61, 01, 14 of Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
