1. Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Mr. Naveen Nara, DEEO, Charkhi Dadri, informs that the concurrence from the Finance Department has now been received in terms of benefits payable to the petitioner and the same shall be released in his favour within a week from today.
2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
