HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, submits that the financial benefits / arrears with respect to two increments payable to Sh. B.K. Dhir (petitioner in EA-13-2020 in LPA-198-2003), shall be released within one week from today.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, no further orders are required to be passed in the present contempt petition.

[3] **Disposed off accordingly.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, Registry to revive the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner-Sh. B.K. Dhir towards litigation expenses,

immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Also, liberty is granted to the petitioner-Sh. B.K. Dhir to avail the remedy including the execution petition, as per law, with respect to his claim regarding two other increments.

[6] Rule stands discharged.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
