1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willfully disobeying the interim order dated 09.07.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed in CR-3778-2024, whereby parties were directed to maintain *status quo* regarding the property in question.

2. Status report dated 21.08.2025 already filed by way of affidavit of respondent No.3, on behalf of respondent Nos.3 & 4, is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite counsel. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. It is not disputed that aforesaid civil revision is still pending adjudication. It is also not in dispute that the matter requires recording of evidence. Moreover, as per the reply filed on behalf of respondent Nos.3 & 4, statement of respondent No.1-Jagir Singh has



been recorded by respondent No.3-ASI Sham Singh, wherein respondent No.1 has stated that decision of the Court shall be acceptable to him and henceforth, he shall not raise any construction on the shops in question.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances and the decision by the larger Bench dated 14.10.2024 in CACP-20-2016, titled as *Rajbir and others Vs. Raj Singh (since deceased) through LRs.* present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate alternate remedy, as per law.

5. Rule stands discharged.

6. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
