Pursuant to the order dated 27.05.2019, petitioner appeared before the District Education Officer (Secondary Education), District Gurdaspur and an amount of ₹526/- was found due to the petitioner.

Petitioner who is present in person states that though he has received the monetary benefits but no formal order has been communicated to him with regard to counting of his military service. At this stage, petitioner has been handed over a document in which the calculation of benefit given to the military service is there. He further submits that he has a grievance that the period of military service has not been correctly calculated.

In view of the fact that military service of the petitioner has been counted and he has received the monetary benefit, no further cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

Petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case he has grievance with regard to the calculation of period of military service.
