SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Petitioner has challenged notice, Annexure P1, issued to him to appear before DCP (Crimes against Women/Children) to inquire into a complaint filed by his estranged wife. Reliance has been placed by counsel for the petitioner upon instructions dated 01.04.2008, Annexure P4, as well as judgment dated 12.01.2009, Annexure P5, passed by this Court on a petition filed under Section 482, Cr.P.C.
2. Petitioner has not been able to satisfy this Court as the maintainability of petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India particularly when the complaint against him pertains to allegations of

harassment and cruelty.

3. Petition is dismissed as not maintainable.

4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the remedies available to him in accordance with law.
