Compliance report by way of affidavit of Sh. Maninder Singh, Sr. Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) filed in Court today is taken on record. A copy thereof has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioners.

2. Paragraphs 5, 6 and 7 of the affidavit states as under:-

“5. That the Petitioners in the present contempt petition has stated that a representation (Annexure P-7) was sent to the office of the deponent via email and no action has been taken in this regard. The email was received in the office of the deponent and was endorsed with No. 1292/PPCD dated 10.06.2025 and the same was forwarded to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Majitha, Amritsar Rural, to consider the contents of the representation.

6. That however, it is pertinent to mention here that the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Majitha, Amritsar (Rural) after considering the contents of the representation, submitted a report wherein it was stated that no action is required to be taken on the representation, as representation No. 4300-LIT dated 10.06.2025 was submitted by the petitioners on similar facts, which has already been consigned to the



record room (as already detailed above) as the petitioners got recorded their statement wherein they stated that they have no threat to their lives and liberty from their parents and do not want any further action on their petition and do not want any police protection and are residing peacefully in Village Waryam Nangal.

Thus, on the basis of the report dated 14.06.2025 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Majitha, Amritsar (Rural), the representation was consigned to the record room.

7. That it is humbly submitted that keeping in mind the fact that security of each and every citizen is responsibility of the State, the deponent has directed the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Majitha, Amritsar (Rural), to personally make sure that the important numbers of Police Control Room, PCR and Station House Officer, Police Station Kathunangal, Amritsar (Rural), are supplied to the petitioners, so that in case of any emergency, they can inform the police and prompt action can be taken, in accordance with law.”

3. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

4. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule is discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
