1. Petitioner(s) filed petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 0075 dated 25.11.2023, registered under Sections 452, 427, 323, 324, 379-B, 506, 34 of IPC, at Police Station Rureke Kalan, District Barnala (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner(s), in light of the compromise effected between parties (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 28.08.2024:

“Petitioner(s) filed petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 0075 dated 25.11.2023, registered under Sections 452, 427, 323, 324, 379-B, 506, 34 of IPC, at Police Station Rureke Kalan, District Barnala (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner(s), in light of the compromise effected between parties (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State.



Mr. Rahul Verma, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Let the statements of petitioner and respondent No.2 be recorded with regard to the compromise on or before 25.09.2024 by learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate concerned, as per the convenience of said Court. In the event of their statements being recorded, the Court will send copies of the same to this Court before the next date of hearing along with its report i.e.

- 1. The number of accused in the aforesaid FIR and to report whether any of the accused has been declared proclaimed offender(s) or any such proceedings have been initiated or pending against them.*
- 2. Whether the compromise entered between the parties is genuine voluntary without any coercion or undue influence.*
- 3. Statement of IO regarding involvement of petitioner(s) in any other FIR.*
- 4. Status of the trial pending before the Court.*

To await the report, list again on 25.10.2024.

Status report be filed by respondent – State by the adjourned date.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466** and **Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63** and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (CrI.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 0075 dated 25.11.2023, registered under Sections 452,
