HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Status report by way of an affidavit of Mr. Naveen Kumar (HCS), Estate Officer, HSVP, Faridabad has been filed on behalf of respondents, the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that upon assessment of compensation, the same has been sanctioned and will be deposited with the Reference Court.

Surprisingly, once the petitioners are before this Court, the amount of compensation needs to be paid to them directly, especially, when there is no dispute about their entitlement or even qua apportionment.

Accordingly, respondents are directed to deposit the compensation directly in the bank accounts of the petitioners within two days of their furnishing indemnity bonds with the respondents.

Disposed of in the above terms.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.

In case the needful is not done within one week after furnishing of the indemnity bonds, 1/3rd salary of respondent Nos.2 and 3 shall remain attached till the needful is done.
