The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of notional pay fixation to the petitioners with the effect from the date their juniors have been appointed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case the second respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 20.12.2024, Annexure P-6, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rohit Arya, DAG, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice shall be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent/Director, Elementary Education, to consider and decide the pending legal notice, dated 20.12.2024,



by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
