1. Petitioner seeks setting aside of order dated 15.05.2025 of learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was facing trial in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Sri Muktsar Sahib in FIR No.0181 dated 05.06.2020 under Sections 376, 384, 506, 120-B, 34 IPC 1860, Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib. He was on bail in that case. On 15.05.2025, petitioner could not appear before the Court due to illness of his mother on which account learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Sri Muktsar Sahib cancelled and forfeited his bail and surety bonds. He further submits that he has instructions to state that petitioner will surrender before the learned Trial Court and join the proceedings.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Kunwarbir Singh, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Heard. Order dated 15.05.2025 reveals that bail order of the petitioner has not been cancelled. All he is required to do is to surrender

before learned Trial Court and furnish fresh bail and surety bonds in terms of order of this Court. Accordingly, petitioner is directed to put in appearance before learned Trial Court, Sri Muktsar Sahib on the next date of hearing i.e. 23.10.2025, move appropriate application for surrender and take the trial to its logical conclusion. Learned Trial Court shall decide the application on that very day, without granting any adjournment. Till then, no coercive action shall be taken.

6. Petition stands disposed of.
