The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing order dated 09.12.2022, Annexure P-6, whereby the petitioner has been relieved from the job of Para-Teaching Associates (TGT Hindi) at Job Role Level-3.

2. It is apparent on record that the petitioner was relieved on account of not possessing the requisite qualification, i.e., Haryana Teacher Eligibility Test (HTET) Level-2. The challenge has been made on the ground that there was no requirement for the candidate to possess such a certificate, and the petitioner already had HTET Level-1 certificate dated 18.12.2015, Annexure P-9. Therefore, she could not have been considered ineligible for the job.

3. Be that as it may, it remains undisputed that the deployment offer letter dated 31.05.2023, Annexure P-7, was issued to the petitioner for a term deployment only from 01.06.2023 to 31.03.2024. Therefore, at this stage, she



cannot be considered for appointment, and the matter has been rendered infructuous.

4. Disposed of as such.
