Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.66 dated 12.8.2024 registered under Sections 331(6), 118(1), 115(2), 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Bhadaur, District Barnala.

2. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that by virtue of the previous order, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police and further, now the matter has been settled between the parties by way of compromise. Copy of the report submitted by concerned mediator coupled with that of settlement agreement is taken on record.

3. State counsel on instructions from Inspector Gurwinder Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the State counsel and

further submits that the petitioner, who has joined investigation, is no longer required for purpose of further investigation by the police.

4. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 21.10.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
