way of compromise.

Discussed.

A statement made on behalf of the appellant(s) that in full
and final satisfaction of their claim, an amount of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees
Eighty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the
tribunal be awarded and be disbursed to the appellant(s), in the same
ratio as apportioned by the learned MACT having been accepted on
behalf of the insurer of the offending vehicle, the appeal is disposed of
with a direction to the insurer to deposit with the office of the Lok
Adalat a cheque in the sum of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand
Only), favouring the appellant(s) in the same ratio as apportioned by
the learned MACT, within two months from today, failing which the
amount hereby awarded shall carry interest @ 9% per annum from the
date of this order till payment thereof.

The cheques so deposited may be collected by the above-
named appellant(s) or the counsel representing the appellant(s) against
proper receipt.

Miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.

A copy of this order be made available to each of the
appearing counsel, and file be consigned.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the files of the
connected appeals.
