1. Petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter-alia* for issuance of a writ, in the nature of *mandamus*, directing the respondents to withdraw Lookout Notice issued against the petitioner in connection with FIR No.79 dated 15.09.2020, Annexure P-1, registered at Women Police Station, Panchkula.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
3. Similar was the position on the previous two occasions.
4. State counsel has invited the attention of the Court to order dated 16.01.2024, wherein counsel for the petitioner stated that parties have resolved the issues amicably and he had sought adjournment to file the requisite document.
5. It seems that in view of the above development, petitioner is not interested in pursuing the petition.
6. Dismissed in default for want of prosecution.
