VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. The present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 05.12.2019 (Annexure P-8) passed by Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Karnal, vide which the execution petition filed by the petitioner/deGREE holder has been transferred to the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Division) Bangalore for further proceedings.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent has produced a copy of order dated 29.11.2024, passed by the Labour Court, Panipat, which is taken on record and marked as Mark 'A'. Copy of the same has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner to highlight the fact that the matter has been compromised and the petitioner has undertaken before the said Labour Court that he would withdraw the present case.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition but liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case the abovesaid statement is not factually correct.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
