HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that the amount due towards the petitioner in terms of the decision dated 22.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Writ Court shall be paid to him within three weeks from today; a fresh speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner shall be passed within a week thereafter while forwarding a copy thereof to him immediately.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Disposed off accordingly.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek

revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
