On the basis of Reference minutes of the meeting dated 21.2.2024 held by the Hon'ble Arrears Committee, the efforts have been made to procure the copy of paper book as well as present status, however, as per office report dated 16.7.2024 no documents have been procured and Mr. N.K. Malhotra, Advocate learned counsel for the petitioner has been informed about the date fixed.

However, despite that there was no representation on behalf of petitioner on the last date of hearing i.e. 15.10.2025 and the Predecessor Bench had directed that as it is totally burnt case, notice be issued to counsel representing the parties.
