VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (Oral):

1. Compliance report by way of additional affidavit of Ms. Jaspreet Talwar, Additional Chief Secretary to the Government of Punjab, Department of Mines and Geology, Chandigarh, on behalf of respondent No.1, filed in Court today, is taken on record. Copy has been furnished to learned counsel representing the petitioner.
2. Mr. Shekhar Verma, Addl.A.G.
