MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, praying for quashing of FIR No.107 dated 04.12.2021 (P-1), under Sections 452, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 01.04.2023 (P-2), arrived at between the parties.

2. Case called twice; but none appeared on behalf of the petitioner. On earlier occasion also, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel submits that in terms of the order dated 20.04.2023, although parties came forward for recording their statement before learned trial Court but it was reported that there are six accused arrayed in the present FIR; however only one petitioner has



entered into compromise with respondent No.2; thus it is partial quashing petition.

4. In view of the above, it appears that petitioner has lost interest in the matter.

5. Consequently, there is no option except to dispose off the same for non-prosecution.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. Needless to say that in case an occasion so arises, petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
