Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 30.5.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-13449 of 2024 titled as “Mahipal and others vs. State of Haryana and others”, vide which the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the respondents to the effect that “...in case, the legal notice dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same



*will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed.”*

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 30.10.2024 by the respondent-authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 30.10.2024 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since the order dated 30.5.2024 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with and the Speaking Order dated 30.10.2024 has been passed by the respondent-authority, the present petition may be **disposed of**. However, the petitioner be granted liberty to challenge the aforesaid Speaking Order as per law.

In view of the above, the present petition is **disposed of** accordingly with the liberty aforesaid to the petitioner.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
