The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 24.08.2021, passed by this Court in CRM-M-34534-2021, vide which, without commenting on the merits of the case, a direction was issued to SSP, Ferozepur to look into the matter and dispose of the representations filed by the petitioner.

As per affidavit of the SSP, Ferozepur, filed today in Court, an inquiry was marked and the petitioner was called by the DSP, Tarn Taran, wherein she made a statement on 18.10.2021 that she does not want to pursue her complaints as the matter is likely to be compromised between the parties. She further stated that if the compromise does not take effect, she will file a fresh complaint. Thereafter, the Inquiry Officer/DSP, Tarn Taran recommended to file the complaints.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh, submits that the petitioner has not given any fresh complaint so far, in terms of her statement recorded on 18.10.2021, therefore, the present petition may

be rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner could not rebut that the petitioner, at one point of time, has made the aforesaid statement before the Inquiry Officer and subsequent thereto, she has not moved any fresh complaint.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.
