As agreed, (statement of learned counsel for the appellant(s) as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.5,70,000/- (Rupees Five Lacs Seventy Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant No.1-Vahidan and appellant No.2-Idrish in equal share in full and final settlement of the claim.

Learned counsel for the appellants stated that agreed amount be released in favour of appellant No.1-Vahidan and appellant No.2-Idrish in equal share. It was further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other claimant(s), appellant No.1 and appellant No.2 shall indemnify the said claimant(s).

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque of Rs.5,70,000/- (Rupees Five Lacs Seventy Thousand only) in favour of appellant No.1-Vahidan and appellant No.2-Idrish in equal share with the office of the Lok Adalat of

the High Court on or before 12.12.2025. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant(s) counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be consigned to the record room.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
