VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

This is an application preferred under Order 23 Rule 3 CPC for placing on record the compromise deed as Annexure A-1 and for disposal of the appeal in terms of the said compromise.

2. Document i.e., compromise deed dated 14.05.2024 Annexure A-1 is taken on record.

3. It has been averred in the application that parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and a compromise deed dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure A-1) has been executed. It has been averred that in view of the compromise having been arrived at, the appeal be disposed in terms of the said compromise.

4. Learned Senior Counsel representing the appellants, Sh. Akshay Kumar Goyal, Advocate, representing respondents No.2 to 4 and Sh.

Ajay Kumar-respondent No.1 who is present in Court submit that the compromise has been voluntarily arrived at between the parties. A self attested photocopy of Aadhaar Card of respondent No.1 which has been furnished by respondent No.1 in Court is retained on record.
