1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to revise the pension and gratuity of the petitioner correctly under the 6th Punjab Pay Commission by taking into account the increment awarded to him w.e.f. 1.10.2012 and restore pay parity with junior employees.
2. Learned counsel would contend that regarding the claim raised in the present petition, detailed representations dated 20.09.2024 and 22.01.2025, Annexures P-26 and 27, respectively, have been submitted, which have yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.
3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to

the respondents to decide the representations dated 20.09.2024 and 22.01.2025, within a period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
