



3. Mr. T.P.S Chawla, Sr. DAG accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from Mr. Gurmeet Singh, SDM, Zira, submits that all efforts are being made to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India so as to conclude the proceedings of the Election Petition as early as possible but keeping in view the fact that Lawyers seek adjournment from time to time, the delay in concluding the proceedings is occurring.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the next date of hearing before the Tribunal in the present case is 21.08.2025 and within a period of *three months* from the said date, the proceedings will be concluded, in case the petitioners as well as the respondents cooperate and does not seek further adjournments.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
