Main case

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, against the respondents for deliberate and wilful disobedience of order dated 04.02.2024 passed by the Court of Shri Ashwani Kumar, Civil Judge (Junior Division) Karnal in Civil Suit No. 322 of 1999.

2. After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition with liberty to avail legally available alternate remedy in the matter.

3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, if the petitioner is having any grievance, he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law,
