1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.97, dated 08.11.2023, under Section 377 of IPC and Sections 6, 10 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he does not want to press the present petition at this stage and the same be dismissed as such. He however has submitted that despiteailable warrants, the prosecution witnesses were not available for their examination.



3. Learned State counsel on instructions has submitted that out of 14 prosecution witnesses, no witness has been examined and the next date before the learned trial Court is 13.02.2025.

4. Dismissed as not pressed at this stage. However the prosecution is directed to produce the witnesses and the learned trial Court is requested to examine them on the date fixed before it.
