The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.277 dated 30.07.2010 under Sections 419/465/468/506 of IPC, Section 66 of Information Technology Act, 2000 and Section 25 of Telegraph Act, 1885 registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurugram (Annexure P-1) as well as quashing of challan dated 23.03.2022 (Annexure P-4) and all consequential and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, quashing of order dated 16.12.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram and all other consequential proceedings including quashing of FIR No.1150 dated 27.12.2021 under Section 174-A of IPC registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, Gurugram (Annexure P-3) and order of attachment dated 20.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom and further private criminal complaint COMI 411-2015 dated 17.07.2015 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset submits that
