Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 28.2.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-5556-2025 titled as "Lal Singh vs. State of Haryana and others", vide which the writ petition was disposed of with a direction "*.....to respondent No.3-Divisional Forest Officer, Rewari, Forest Division, Rewari, to decide the representation dated 01.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) followed by subsequent reminders dated 30.07.2024 and 02.09.2024 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) submitted by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of*



receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, if prescribed under law.”

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions, undertakes that the Speaking Order shall be passed on the representations of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent, the present petition may be disposed of.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

However, in case the needful is not done as per the above undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
