1. The present petition was filed in the year 2004 i.e. 21 years ago challenging the award dated 24.12.2002, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-1, by which, the benefit of backwages was denied to the petitioner.
2. The benefit of backwages can only be granted in case the facts and the evidence which comes on record shows that the Workman was not gainfully employed during the period after termination and in the present case, no such fact or evidence was brought on record so as to claim the benefit of backwages.
3. No one is appearing on behalf of the petitioner hence, the petitioner must have retired as of now and might not be interested in pursuing the present remedy.
4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
