This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 17.02.2018 passed in CWP No. 3766 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

" Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-7) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulation as well as in view of the judgments referred in para 1 of this judgment, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court."

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 and 5 has filed a short reply by way of an affidavit of Balwinder Kumar Garg, Divisional Engineer, Tubewell Division, Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation Ltd. Malerkotla, District Sangrur, annexing the order dated 12.02.2019. The claim of the petitioner has been accepted and he is found entitled to an amount of ₹1,94,636/- on account of retiral benefits. Copy of receipt of payments made is also produced

In view of the reply filed, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

While disposing of writ petition, the petitioner was granted liberty to approach this Court if still any grievance survives. Needless to add that in case the petitioner still has any grievance he would be at liberty to avail remedy as available in accordance with law.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.
