MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.472 dated 23.11.2024 registered under Sections 115, 190, 191(3), 333 and 351(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNS'), at Police Station Ambala Cantt, District Ambala along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 25.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. This Court vide order dated 03.12.2024 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Sessions Judge has submitted report dated 10.01.2025 to the effect that the compromise has



been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent Nos. 2 and 3 has not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.472 dated 23.11.2024 registered under Sections 115, 190, 191(3), 333 and 351(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNS'), at Police Station Ambala Cantt, District Ambala along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 25.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
