1. This common order shall dispose of the aforementioned civil writ petitions as they arise from a similar factual matrix. However, for the sake of brevity, the facts are taken from CWP-23128-2025.

2. The present civil writ petition(s) has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits of monthly pension calculated on higher wages along with interest @ 18% from the date it became due till its realization.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that he would be satisfied if the legal notice (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner(s) is decided by the

respondents by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner(s), the respondents are directed to consider the legal notice (Annexure P-8) of the petitioners and pass a speaking order, after affording them an opportunity to be heard, within a period of 03 months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioners. Needless to say, if the petitioners are found entitled to the relief sought, the same shall be granted forthwith by the respondents.

5. Disposed of, accordingly.
