**SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)**

1. Through the instant petition, as filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have sought issuance of directions upon the official respondents, to ensure protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6, and, also to restrain the said respondent from harassing the petitioners or interfering in their peaceful life.
2. Notice of motion to the official respondent(s) only.
3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. K.D. Sachdeva, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondent(s).
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed a civil suit against the private respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and during the pendency of the said civil suit, the private respondents are now harassing and threatening the petitioners. Therefore, he prays that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation of the petitioners filed before SHO, Sangrur (Punjab) on 23.05.2025.



5. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the whole file of the case with his able assistance.

6. Since in the present case, the civil suit between the parties is already going on, therefore, this Court did not feel it appropriate to entertain the present petition.

7. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

8. Pending application (s), if any, also stand disposed of.
