Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that though prior to the passing of the order by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in ***CWP No.33460 of 2024 titled as M/s Baba Dittuji Highways Bus Service vs. State of Punjab and others***, the petitioners had already approached for considering their name to be brought in the time table so that there is no ambiguity with regard to the time the petitioners can ply buses on the route qua which the permit has been granted till the passing of the fresh order in appeal by the respondent-State but the petitioners are not being considered.

Learned counsel for the respondents, keeping in view the written instructions received, submits that keeping in view the order passed by this Court in *CWP No.33460 of 2024*, the opportunity of hearing has already been given to the petitioner and only the final order is to be passed and the same will be passed within the time limit granted and in case after the passing of the order with regard to the validity of the permit, the petitioners, in case found eligible to be considered for issuing the composite time table, the said action will be undertaken without any fail within a period of further two weeks of the passing of the fresh order.

5. Keeping in view the statement given by the learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of.
