**HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 and 2 to demarcate the land under the supervision of committee of Deputy Commissioner, Bhiwani, as per the procedure provided in the *Vol (1), Chapter 1 part M of the Punjab and*

*Haryana High Court rules and orders and para No.4.49 of part H of the Haryana Land Records Manual, 2013*, as per revenue record qua the Government Land measuring 23 kanal 9 marla, situated in Khasra No.735 Revenue Estate, Loharu, on which Government School, Office of the Block Education Officer is situated.

1.1. A further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.1 to conduct a fair and impartial enquiry under the supervision of Higher Officers of the Revenue Department qua the Government Land measuring 23 kanal 9 marla situated in Khasra No.735, Revenue Estate, Loharu (on which Government Sr. Sec. School, Office of the Block Education Officer is situated), which was illegally transferred vide Sale Deed No.1515 dated 14.03.2019 executed by Mahender Singh etc. in favour of one Neetu Dahiya i.e. respondent No.9 in complete violation of the provisions of Haryana Registration Manual, 1967 and also for the reasons delineated herein as under in the present writ petition and in the interest of justice and fair play.

2. Mr. Ankit Goel, Advocate appears and files Memo of Appearance on behalf of respondents No.6 and 7 in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

3. During the course of hearing, learned counsel for respondents No.6 and 7 has stated that so far as the claim of the petitioners regarding Khasra No.735 situated in Revenue Estate, Loharu (on which Government Model Primary School, Loharu is established) is concerned, the respondents have no concern with the said area and even in the sale deed No.1515 dated 14.03.2019, there is no mention of Khasra No.735.

4. At this stage, Mr. Rajesh K. Sheron, counsel for the petitioners submits that with the above statement made by learned counsel for respondents No.6 and 7, the grievance of the petitioners stands addressed;

therefore, the present writ petition may be disposed of accordingly.

5. Ordered accordingly.
6. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
