Main case

1. By way of instant petition filed under Section 11 (5) and 11 (6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short "the Act"), petitioner has approached this Court for appointment of an Arbitrator in terms of Clause 16 of agreement dated 31.01.2017, Annexure P-1.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that although in his response dated 22.04.2024, Annexure P-3, to the notice issued by the respondent, petitioner had requested for appointment of an Arbitrator, but during the pendency of the instant petition, he has issued a legal notice, Annexure P-4, invoking the arbitration clause. He submits that as the instant petition has been filed prior to the issuance of notice, Annexure P-4, he may be permitted to withdraw it with liberty to file afresh one.
3. His request is accepted.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
5. Pending application(s), if any, is disposed of.
