1. This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail under Section 483 of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 439 of Cr.P.C) in case FIR No.240 dated 05.06.2023 under Sections 302, 201 and 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Tehsil Camp, District Panipat.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the deceased-Fakre Alam alias Munna, was killed by the petitioner and his co-accused and, thereafter, his body was burnt at Uttarakhand.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and there is no evidence against the present petitioner to convict him. Moreover, the petitioner has already undergone the custody of 02 years, 02 months and 20 days. Thus, he is entitled for the grant of regular bail.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel has pointed out that at the behest of the petitioner, police recovered a golden colour Timex Watch and a

brown coloured purse belonging to the deceased, which were lying between the bricks and under a flyover. Moreover, a CCTV footage has also been procured by the prosecution showing the last seen evidence, of the deceased travelling with the present petitioner alongwith his co-accused. Moreover, the petitioner has already undergone the custody of 02 years, 02 months and 20 days and out total 40 prosecution witnesses only 06 have been examined so far.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances of the present case, no ground is made out to grant him the concession of bail. Hence, the present petition is **dismissed**.
